This second conception of morality unlike the first is not shaped by the aim of getting it right or the contrast between correct and merely supposed moral requirements It is shaped by the moral aim of practicing morality with others within an actual not merely hypothetical scheme of social cooperation If practices based on misguided moral norms seem not to be genuine morality under the first conception merely hypothetical practices seem not to be the genuine article under the second conception.
