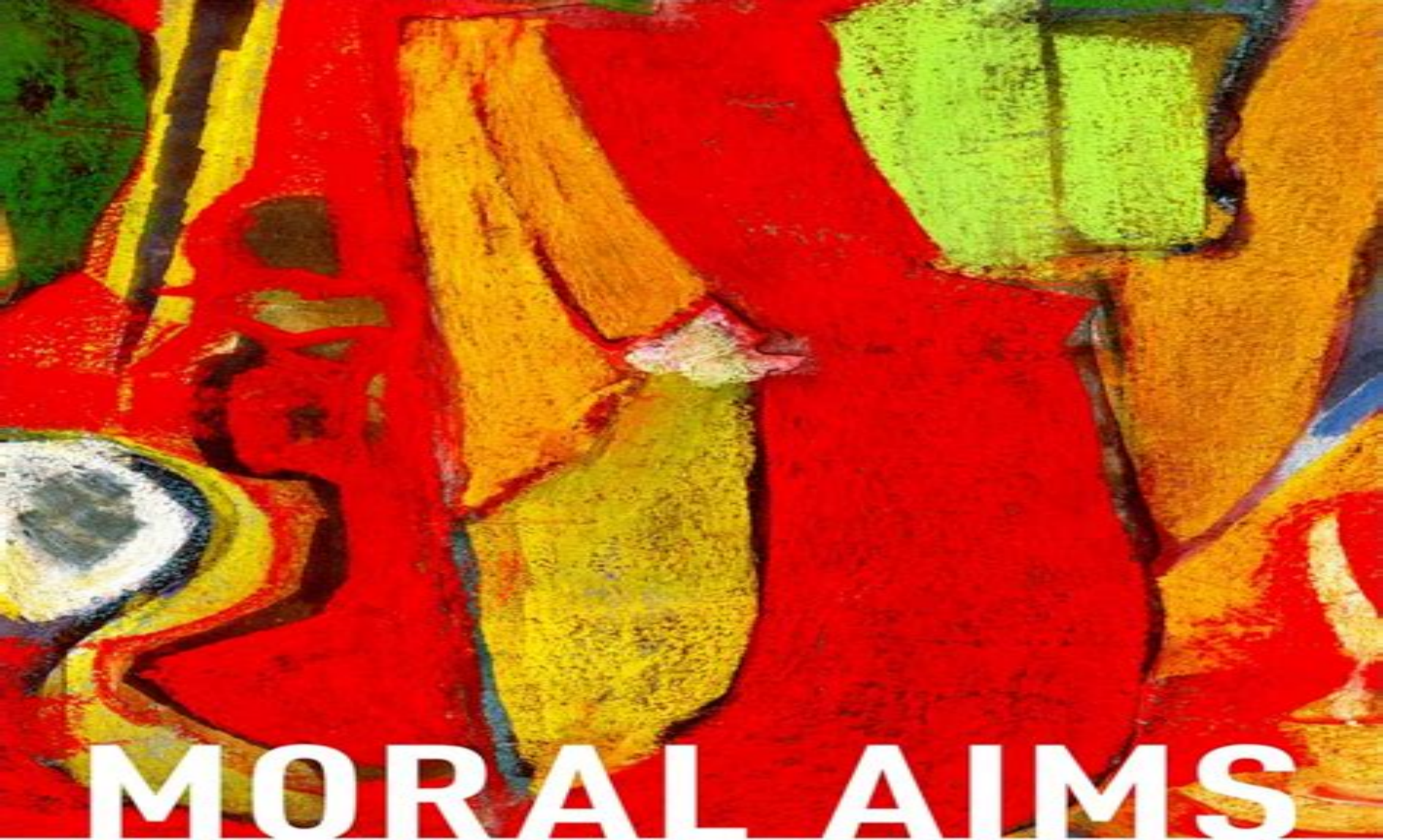

Moral Aims Cheshire Calhoun, 2015-11-02 We rely on two different conceptions of morality On the one hand we think of morality as a correct action guide Morality is accessed by taking up a critical reflective point of view where our concern is with identifying the moral rules that would be the focus of the requiring activities of persons in a hypothetical social world whose participants were capable of accessing the justifications for everyone's endorsing just this set of rules On the other hand in doing virtually anything connected with morality making demands offering excuses justifying choices expressing moral attitudes getting uptake on our resentments and the like we rely on social practices of morality and shared moral understandings that make our moral activities and attitudes intelligible to others This second conception of morality unlike the first is not shaped by the aim of getting it right or the contrast between correct and merely supposed moral requirements It is shaped by the moral aim of practicing morality with others within an actual not merely hypothetical scheme of social cooperation If practices based on misguided moral norms seem not to be genuine morality under the first conception merely hypothetical practices seem not to be the genuine article under the second conception The premise of this book which collects together nine previously published essays and a new introduction is that both conceptions are indispensable But exactly how is the moral theorist to go about working simultaneously with two such different conceptions of morality The book's project is not to construct an overarching methodology for handling the two conceptions of morality Instead it is to provide case studies of that work being done

to the world around us Rushdy then discusses how ingratitude instead of indicating a moral failure can also act as an important principle and ethical stand against injustice Rushdy asserts that if we practice gratitude as a moral recognition of the other then that gratitude varies alongside the different kinds of benefactors who receive it ranging from the person who provides an expected service or gift to the divine or natural sources whom we may credit with our very existence By arguing for the necessity of analyzing gratitude as a philosophical concept Rushdy reminds us of our capacity and appreciation for gratitude simply as an acknowledgment and acceptance of our humble dependency on and connectedness with our families friends communities environments and universe

Christopher Maloney,2023-04-24 Do we have free will How could we have the psychological leeway to choose and act otherwise than we do The sum of history and the laws of science including psychology deterministically imply all events including each of our actions Is nature s iron determination of deliberation compatible with the will s freedom The philosophers who answer affirmatively both classical and current assume that either the ultimate scientific laws or the grand historical record or both are merely contingent By proceeding to infer the contingency of lawfully determined actions these compatibilists would secure the leeway presumably requisite for the will s liberty Akratic Compatibilism and All Too Human Psychology Almost Enough Is Free Will Enough argues however that they may be dead wrong about the modality of nature s laws and history s plasticity Might the laws be necessary and history absolutely fixed Nevertheless J Christopher Maloney posits we would yet be free For psychology ordains volitional conflict sometimes we akratically will to be able to act otherwise than we irresistibly do Being akratic by nature we asymptotically resist even a necessitating psychology s governance That Sisyphean resistance against the laws of cognition almost achieves the will s liberating leeway Nevertheless almost free is free enough for deliberators as weak willed as we
