Helm, 2017-07-26 Communities of respect are communities of people sharing common practices or a partial way of life they include families clubs religious groups and political parties This book develops a detailed account of such communities in terms of the rational structure of their members' reactive attitudes emotions like resentment gratitude guilt approbation and indignation whereby people hold

each other responsible to certain norms Helm argues that these communities are fundamental in three interrelated ways to understanding what it is to be a person First it is only by being a member of a community of respect that one can be a responsible agent having dignity such an agent therefore has certain rights as well as the authority to demand that fellow members recognize her dignity and follow the norms of the community compliance with which norms they likewise have the authority to demand from her Second by prescribing or proscribing both actions and values communities of respect can shape the identities of their members in ways that others have the authority to enforce thereby revealing an important interpersonal dimension of the identities of persons Finally all of this is grounded in a distinctively interpersonal form of practical rationality in virtue of which we jointly have reasons to recognize the dignity and authority of fellow members and so to comply with their authoritative demands as well as to respect and so comply with the norms of the community Hence we persons are essentially social creatures

Emotions and Mass Atrocity Thomas Brudholm, Johannes Lang, 2018-03-22

Kershnar, 2023-12-01 Our worldview assumes that people are morally responsible Our emotions beliefs and values assume that a person is responsible for what she thinks and does and that this is a good thing This book argues that this worldview is false It provides four arguments for this conclusion that build on the free will and responsibility literatures in original and insightful ways Foundation No one is responsible because there is no foundation for responsibility A foundation for responsibility is something for which a person is responsible but not by being responsible for something else Epistemic Condition No one is responsible because no one fulfills the epistemic condition necessary for blameworthiness Internalism If a person were responsible then she would be responsible for and only for what goes on in her head Most of the evidence for responsibility says the opposite Amount No one is responsible because we cannot make sense of what makes a person more or less praiseworthy or blameworthy There is no other book that argues against moral responsibility based on foundationalism the epistemic condition and internalism and shows that these arguments cohere The book's arguments for internalism and quantifying responsibility are new to the literature Ultimately the book's conclusions undermine our commonsense view of the world and the most common philosophical understanding of God morality and relationships

Do To Die To Reason Why offers a new account of the ethics of war and the legal regulation of war It is especially concerned
with the conduct of individuals including whether they are required to follow orders to go to war what moral constraints
there are on killing in war what makes people liable to be killed in war and the extent to which the laws of war ought to
reflect the morality of war Victor Tadros defends a largely anti authority view about the morality of war and notable moral
constraints on killing in war such as the Doctrine of Doing and Allowing and a version of the Doctrine of Double Effect
However he argues that a much wider range of people are liable to be harmed or killed in war than is normally thought to be
the case on grounds of both causal involvement and fairness And it argues that the laws of war should converge much more
closely with the morality of war than is currently the case *Fair Opportunity and Responsibility* David Owen Brink,2021
Fair Opportunity and Responsibility lies at the intersection of moral psychology and criminal jurisprudence and analyzes
responsibility and its relations to desert culpability excuse blame and punishment It links responsibility with the reactive

attitudes but makes the justification of the reactive attitudes depend on a prior and independent conception of responsibility. Responsibility and excuse are inversely related: an agent is responsible for misconduct if and only if it is not excused. As a result, we can study responsibility by understanding excuses. We excuse misconduct when an agent's capacities or opportunities are significantly impaired because these capacities and opportunities are essential if agents are to have a fair opportunity to avoid wrongdoing. This conception of excuse tells us that responsibility itself consists in agents having suitable cognitive and volitional capacities, normative competence, and a fair opportunity to exercise these capacities free from undue interference, situational control. Because our reactive attitudes and practices presuppose the fair opportunity conception of responsibility, this supports a predominantly retributive conception of blame and punishment that treats culpable wrongdoing as the desert basis of blame and punishment. We can then apply the fair opportunity framework to assessing responsibility and excuse in circumstances of structural injustice, situational influences in ordinary circumstances, and in wartime insanity and psychopathy, immaturity, addiction, and crimes of passion. Though fair opportunity has important implications for each issue, treating them together allows us to explore common themes and appreciate the need to take partial responsibility and excuse seriously in our practices of blame and punishment.

Conversation and Responsibility Michael McKenna, 2012-03-28

In this book, Michael McKenna advances a new theory of moral responsibility, one that builds upon the work of P. F. Strawson. As McKenna demonstrates, moral responsibility can be explained on analogy with a conversation. The relation between a morally responsible agent and those who hold her morally responsible is similar to the relation between a speaker and her audience. A responsible agent's actions are bearers of agent meaning, just as a speaker's utterances are bearers of speaker meaning. Agent meaning is a function of the moral quality of the will with which the agent acts. Those who hold an agent morally responsible for what she does do so by responding to her as if in a conversation. By responding with certain morally reactive attitudes, such as resentment or indignation, they thereby communicate their regard for the meaning taken to be revealed in that agent's actions. It is then open for the agent held responsible to respond to those holding her responsible by offering an apology, a justification, an excuse, or some other response, thereby extending the evolving conversational exchange. The conversational theory of moral responsibility that McKenna develops here accepts two features of Strawson's theory: that moral responsibility is essentially interpersonal, so that being responsible must be understood by reference to the nature of holding responsible, and that the moral emotions are central to holding responsible. While upholding these two aspects of Strawson's theory, McKenna's theory rejects a further Strawsonian thesis, which is that holding morally responsible is more fundamental or basic than being morally responsible. On the conversational theory, the conditions for holding responsible are dependent on the nature of the agent who is responsible. So holding responsible cannot be more basic than being responsible. Nevertheless, the nature of the agent who is morally responsible is to be understood in terms of sensitivity to those who would make moral demands of her, thereby holding her responsible. Being responsible is therefore also

dependent on holding responsible. Thus neither being nor holding morally responsible is more basic than the other. They are mutually dependent.

Pedagogies of Punishment Winston C. Thompson, John Tillson, 2023-05-18.
