Ancient Mosaic Pavements Rāḥēl Ḥaḳlīlī, 2009 This publication is engaged in issues trends and themes depicted on mosaic pavements discovered in Israel the Gaza Strip and Petra the provinces of ancient Palaestina Prima Secunda and Tertia with comparable floors in Jordan Arabia The majority of the mosaic pavements discussed in this study are dated to the 4th 8th centuries CE Mosaic pavements were the normal medium for decorating the floors of synagogues churches monasteries and chapels as well as public and private buildings Inscriptions found on many of the pavements commemorate
