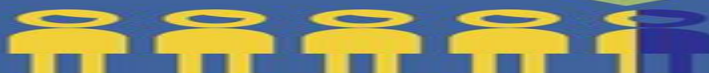

Apply for financial aid no matter what your circumstances. Some merit-based aid can only be awarded if the applicant has submitted financial aid application forms.

4.



Look out for scholarships locally. Find out if your employer offers scholarships or tuition assistance plans for employees or family members. Also look into scholarships that may be offered by your high school, community, or if you're part of one—religious organization.

2.



Take your time and don't rule out any school as too expensive. A generous aid award from a pricey public school can make it less costly than a public school with a lower sticker price.

3.



Never put tuition on a credit card. The debt is more expensive than ever, given recent changes to interest rates and other fees some credit card issuers are now charging.
