Virtually every public college cost increase, however, requires a positive vote from each university's governing board, and the record shows that these votes are nearly always unanimous. Cebula argue that many trustees have forgotten that they should act as fiduciaries who represent the best interests of students, parents, and taxpayers. Instead, Koch and Cebula explain, too often many trustees prize size and more prestigious rankings over access and affordability.
