The yoke it advocates is not as easy as one might suppose, yet both Jews and Christians would recognize its morals as largely the same as those that underpin Judeo-Christian values today. Further, they reflect the requirements that Christian Jews saw as necessary for participation in the Christian community in a day when that community still looked very much to its Jewish progenitors.
