From 1942 to 1948, trains delivered thousands of civilians from the United States and Latin America to Crystal City, Texas, a small desert town at the southern tip of Texas. The trains carried Japanese, German, Italian immigrants and their American-born children. The only family internment camp during World War II, Crystal City was the center of a government prisoner exchange program called Quiet Passage.

term causes and consequences of this fateful wartime decision In his exquisitely written and powerfully documented testament he speaks truth to power making evident why he is eminently qualified to convey the plight of the Nisei draft resisters He perceptively reframes the wartime and postwar experiences of the larger Japanese American community commonly said to have suffered in the spirit of shikata ga nai enduring that which cannot be changed and emerged with dignity Beyond the Betrayal makes abundantly clear that the unjustly imprisoned Nisei could and did exercise their patriotism even when they refused to serve in the military in the name of civil liberties and social justice Kuromiya s account initially privately circulated only to family and friends is an invaluable and insightful addition to the Nikkei historical record
