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The Labour of Subjectivity Andrea Rossi, 2015-11-30 Michel Foucault defined critique as an exercise in de-subjectivation. To what extent did this claim shape his philosophical practice? What are its theoretical and ethical justifications? Why did Foucault come to view the production of subjectivity as a key site of political and intellectual emancipation in the present? Andrea Rossi pursues these questions in *The Labour of Subjectivity*. The book re-examines the genealogy of the politics of subjectivity that Foucault began to outline in his lectures at the Collège de France in the late 1970s and early 1980s. He explores Christian confession, *raison d'état*, biopolitics and bioeconomy as the different technologies by which Western politics has attempted to produce, regulate and give form to the subjectivity of its subjects. Ultimately, Rossi argues that Foucault's critical project can only be comprehended within the context of this historico-political trajectory as an attempt to give the extant politics of the self a new horizon.

Precarious Labour and Informal Economy Smita Yadav, 2018-06-13 An empirical account of one of India's largest indigenous populations, this book tells the story of the Gonds who currently face displacement and governmental control of the region's forests, which has crippled their economy. Rather than protesting and calling for state intervention, the Gonds have turned toward an informal economy; they not only engage with flexible forms of work but also bargain for higher wages and experience agency and autonomy. Smita Yadav conceives of this withdrawal from the state in favour of precarious forms of work as an expression of anarchy by this marginalized population. Even as she provides rich detail of the Gonds' unusual working lives, which integrate work, labour and debt practices with ideologies of family and society, Yadav illustrates the strength required to maintain dignity when a welfare state has failed.

Ethics and Science Education: How Subjectivity Matters Jesse Bazzul, 2016-05-24 This book encapsulates a line of research that looks at how students are positioned as ethical actors/decision makers in biology education by science policy, curriculum and classroom resources. Its basis comes from a textbook study that examined how biology texts work to constitute subjectivities related to neoliberalism and global capitalism, sex, gender and sexuality and ethics. The study found that textbook discourses set limits on (a) the types of ethical concerns represented by the modes of ethical engagement, (b) the dispositions necessary to engage in ethical action or decision making. Policy reform, regulation and personal lifestyle choices were the primary ways students could approach ethical decision making or action. While these approaches are useful, they are likely not sufficient for dealing with major twenty-first century problems such as climate change and social inequality, along with new ethical dimensions introduced by biotechnologies and genomic research. This research brief sets a context for how discourses of science education policy and curricula work to shape a subject of ethics: that is, how students come to see themselves as participants in issues of ethical concern. Drawing from a structural/poststructural philosophical approach, Science and Technology Studies educational research and a methodology based on discourse analysis and ethnography, this book's overall goal is to assist with research into subjectivity, ethics, politics, policy.
