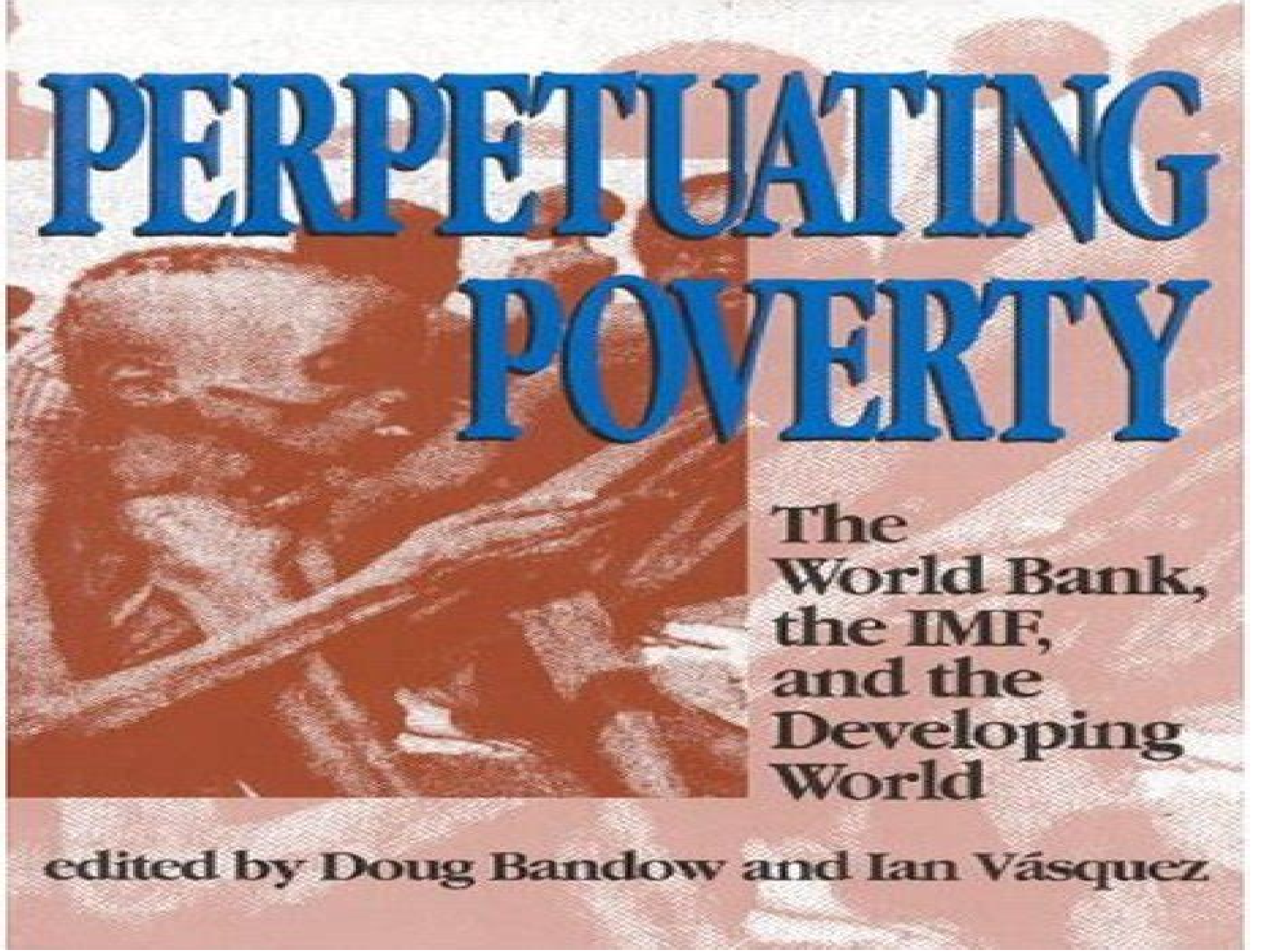

Winters, 2018-08-06 Largely ignored for decades the World Bank increasingly finds itself at the center of an international political maelstrom Attacked by the Right as the last bastion of socialism and by the Left as an instrument of economic imperialism the Bank has struggled to adapt to a changing post Cold War era Still the world's leading development institution in terms of size and influence the International Bank for Reconstruction and Development's failure to articulate and implement a convincing strategy to reduce world poverty has left it vulnerable to the charge that at least in its present form it has outlived its usefulness In a book neither funded nor controlled by its subject leading North American and British scholars critically examine the World Bank They contend that an institution that has grown to unmanageable proportions through internally driven change cannot realistically be expected to effect its own reform program All the Bank's previous attempts at self redesign have failed and the contributors argue it is beyond reform it must be reinvented Reinvention involves a thoroughgoing and externally controlled process of transformation starting from basic principles and encompassing three closely related dimensions operations or the fit between the Bank's lending program and its development objectives concepts its vision of development and anti poverty strategy and power which includes the Bank's relationships with member countries and the wider public as well as structures of internal governance and accountability **The IMF and the Future** Graham Bird, 2014-05-01 The International Monetary Fund has been criticised from both the right and the left of the political spectrum with the right arguing that it is too interventionist and creates more problems than it solves and the left on occasion demanding that it be abolished altogether What seems almost beyond question is that the IMF needs to be reformed Defining a future role for the IMF will always be a controversial issue but vital to any considerations will be a measured assessment of how it has operated in the past This excellent new book from an internationally respected expert on the IMF intends to do just that Starting with an historical background tracing the evolution of the IMF the book goes on to cover such themes as The circumstances under which countries turn to the IMF The various aspects of IMF conditionality Institutional issues such as lending facilities and

Reviving the Invisible Hand Deepak Lal,2010-12-16 Reviving the Invisible Hand is an uncompromising call for a global return to a classical liberal economic order free of interference from governments and international organizations Arguing for a revival of the invisible hand of free international trade and global capital eminent economist Deepak Lal vigorously defends the view that statist attempts to ameliorate the impact of markets threaten global economic progress and stability And in an unusual move he not only defends globalization economically but also answers the cultural and moral objections of antiglobalizers Taking a broad cross

cultural and interdisciplinary approach Lal argues that there are two groups opposed to globalization cultural nationalists who oppose not capitalism but Westernization and new dirigistes who oppose not Westernization but capitalism In response Lal contends that capitalism doesn't have to lead to Westernization as the examples of Japan China and India show and that new dirigiste complaints have more to do with the demoralization of their societies than with the capitalist instruments of prosperity Lal bases his case on a historical account of the rise of capitalism and globalization in the first two liberal international economic orders the nineteenth century British and the post World War II American Arguing that the new dirigisme is the thin edge of a wedge that could return the world to excessive economic intervention by states and international organizations Lal does not shrink from controversial stands such as advocating the abolishment of these organizations and defending the existence of child labor in the Third World

continent After 50 years of political independence many African countries are still exporters of raw materials and cash crops Almost all African countries do not have an integrated market structure that is based on vast division of labor The market sizes of many African countries are very narrow To this day many African countries practice the so called import substitution industrialization which cannot solve the continent s complex problems After the author has examined the failure of the economic policies of the past six decades and their negative impacts he proposes that African countries must introduce a holistic program that effectively solves all the challenges that the continent faces For that they must introduce political and institutional reforms The author believes that without wide range political and institutional reforms and without changing the mindset of the political and economic elite there cannot be any social and economic progress *The Globalizers* Jeffrey T.
