Pavia and the New World the third deals with the relationship between religion and the empire through the examination of royal funerals hagiography and calendric celebrations. The fourth part of the book explores cultural artistic and musical exchange in Naples and Rome Taken together these essays contribute further to our growing appreciation of the importance of early modern festival culture in general and their significance in the world of the Spanish Habsburgs in particular
