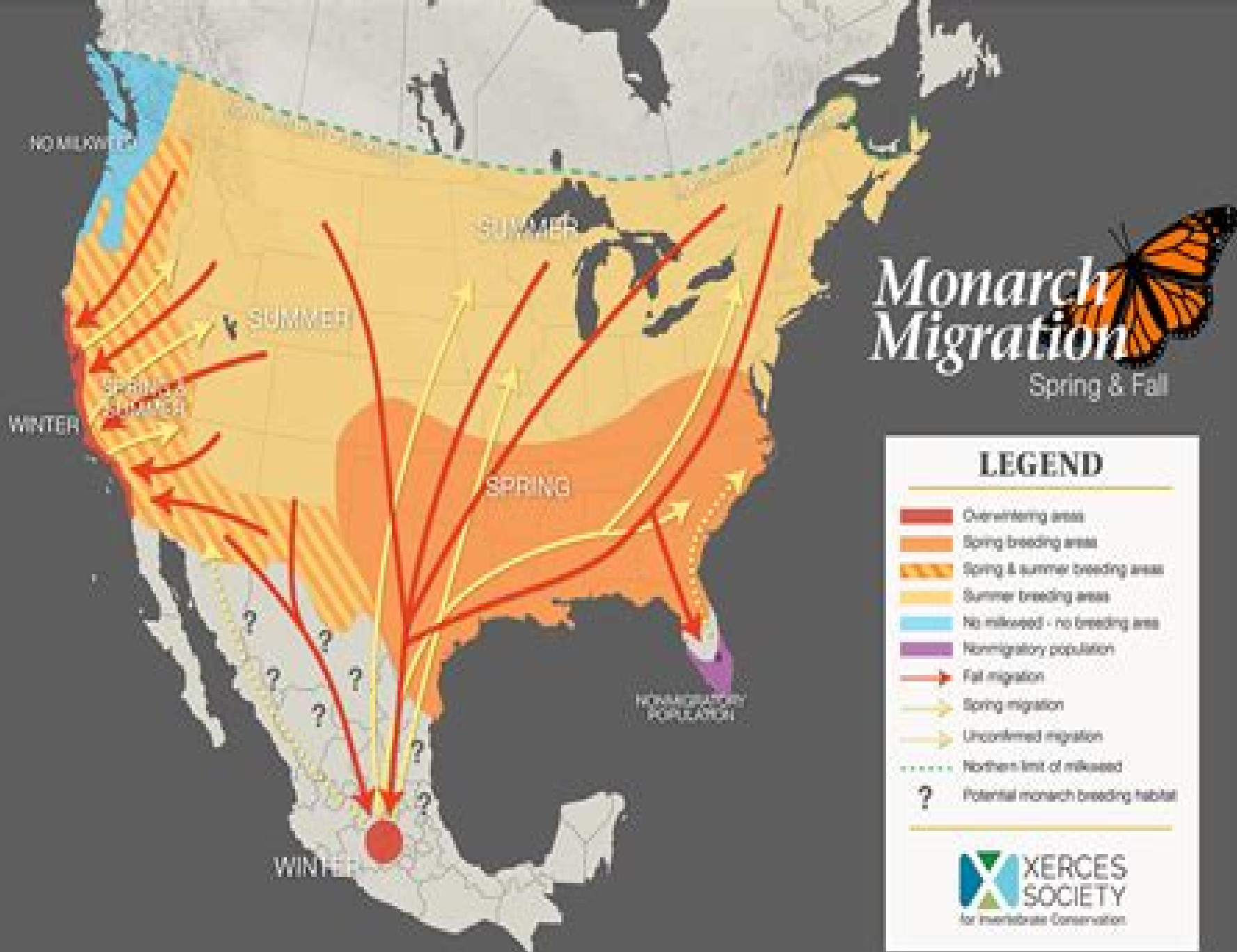

Jones, 2022-04 2023 Nebraska Book Award In the Nebraska Sandhills ranchers on horseback and in pickup trucks share the range with pronghorn antelope burrowing owls and long billed curlews The native grasses grow greener as the cattle grow fatter Throughout the region river otters and mink swim in streams nourished by springs bubbling up from the High Plains Ogallala aquifer Over years of close observation Stephen R Jones has gotten to know the Nebraska Sandhills the twenty thousand square mile expanse of stunning prairie and thriving wetlands He has felt the warm breath of a white tailed doe guarding her spotted fawn learned to communicate with a family of long eared owls and developed an improbable hiking relationship with a wild turkey He has documented a breeding bird population that is growing more diverse and witnessed the long awaited return of nesting trumpeter swans These personal stories accompanied by words of insight from Native American leaders Sandhills ranchers and grassland ecologists help us envision a quiet relationship with the natural world

The Monarch Butterfly Migration Monika Maeckle, 2024-08-20 Each fall millions of monarch butterflies migrate from Canada to Mexico Their incredible journey nearly 3 000 miles long takes them through Oklahoma Texas and other US states where butterfly devotees eagerly await their arrival The monarch migration is a brilliant demonstration of nature's ingenuity but the delicate creatures face many perils and the number of migrating monarchs is declining sharply This compelling book weaves natural history science and personal experience to explore the rise and fall of one of nature's most spectacular phenomena While monarch butterflies have been migrating for centuries they seized public attention in 1976 when a National Geographic magazine cover story featured the discovery of their roosting sites in Mexico The article rocked the world of lepidoptery solved a scientific mystery and opened the door to human meddling The new revelations put a spotlight on the insects and inspired the creation of butterfly sanctuaries in Mexico as well as myriad efforts to protect them Almost 40 years later many believe that monarch butterflies are in danger of extinction How real is that danger Journalist and butterfly advocate Monika Maeckle addresses this question and more as she delves into the rich history and current plight of the monarch butterfly Through meticulous reporting Maeckle offers unique insights on the butterflies as well as a nuanced portrait of the shifting and sometimes contentious community of scientists enthusiasts and flutterati who have emerged to support the monarchs cause A highly engaging book The Monarch Butterfly Migration also focuses a wider lens on the effects of climate change and the tensions between advocacy and scientific accuracy In addition to calling for environmental sustainability this book reminds each of us to notice and never take for granted the natural wonders in our own backyards

Ephemeral by Nature is the next best thing to talking a walk with Stephen Lyn Bales In addition to describing the plants and animals readers will encounter Bales scouts out hidden side trails A look at jack in the pulpit will turn up dinosaurs Darwin and Finding Nemo and consideration of cerulean warblers will lead to coffee in Columbia and a discussion of why the sky is blue Each chapter begins with one of his delightful drawings and you ll find Bales artistic eye is as discerning and detailed as his writing Patricia K Lichen author of Passionate Slugs and Hollywood Frogs and Kidnapping the Wild One In this captivating collection of twelve essays a testament to a lifetime s fascination with the outdoors and its myriad wonders naturalist Stephen Lyn Bales examines a variety of flora and fauna that in one way or another can be described as ephemeral that is fleeting short lived or transient Focusing on his native East Tennessee Bales introduces us to several oddities including the ghost plant a wispy vascular plant that resembles a rooster s tail and grows mainly in areas devoid of sunlight the Appalachian panda an ancestor of today s red panda that wandered the region millions of years ago and whose fossil remains have only recently been discovered and the freshwater jellyfish a tiny organism that is virtually invisible except for those hot summer days when clusters of them bloom into shimmering medusae sometimes by the thousands Other essays consider such topics as the plight of the monarch butterfly a gorgeous insect whose populations have dropped by 90 percent in only the last two decades the reintroduction of the lake sturgeon one of nature s most primitive and seldom seen fish into the waters of the Tennessee Valley and the surprising emergence of coyote wolf and coyote dog hybrids in the eastern states Written with insight humor and heart Ephemeral by Nature is as entertaining as it is instructive Along with a wealth of biological details and his own handsome pen and ink drawings Bales fills the book with delightful anecdotes of field trips species protection efforts and those thrilling occasions when some elusive member of the natural order shows itself to us if only for a brief moment Stephen Lyn Bales senior naturalist at Ijams Nature Center in Knoxville is the author of Natural Histories Stories from the Tennessee Valley and Ghost Birds Jim Tanner and the Quest for the Ivory billed Woodpecker 1935 1941 both published by the University of Tennessee Press

These spectacles articulated the self-image of ruling elites and played out the tensions of the diverse social strata. Responding to the growing academic interest in festivals, this volume focuses on the early modern Iberian world, in particular the spectacles staged by and for the Spanish Habsburgs. The study of early modern Iberian festival culture in Europe and the wider world is surprisingly limited compared to the published works devoted to other kingdoms at the time. There is a clear need for scholarly publications to examine festivals as a vehicle for the presence of Spanish culture beyond territorial boundaries. The present book responds to this shortcoming. Festivals and ceremonials played a major role in the Spanish world through their local identities as well as a common Spanish culture made their presence manifest within and beyond the peninsula through ephemeral displays, music, and print. Local communities often conflated their symbols of identity with religious images and representations of the Spanish monarchy. The festivals, fiestas, in Spanish materialized the presence of the Spanish diaspora in other European realms. Royal funerals and proclamations served to establish kingly presence in distant and not so distant lands. The socio-political, religious, and cultural nuances that were an intrinsic part of the territories of the empire were magnified and celebrated in the Spanish festivals in Europe, Iberia, and overseas viceroyalties. Following a foreword and an introduction, the remaining 12 chapters are divided up into four sections. The first explores Habsburg Visual culture at court and its relationship with the creation of a language of triumph and the use of tapestries in festivals. The second part examines triumphal entries in Madrid, Lisbon, Cremona, Milan.

Pavia and the New World the third deals with the relationship between religion and the empire through the examination of royal funerals hagiography and calendric celebrations The fourth part of the book explores cultural artistic and musical exchange in Naples and Rome Taken together these essays contribute further to our growing appreciation of the importance of early modern festival culture in general and their significance in the world of the Spanish Habsburgs in particular

Byron's Works Byron,2016-01-10 Reprint of the original first published in 1837 *The Mahabharata of Krishna-Dwaipayana Vyasa I* Unbekannt,2016-08-18 The object of a translator should ever be to hold the mirror upto his author That being so his chief duty is to represent so far as practicable the manner in which his author s ideas have been expressed retaining if possible at the sacrifice of idiom and taste all the peculiarities of his author s imagery and of language as well In regard to translations from the Sanskrit nothing is easier than to dish up Hindu ideas so as to make them agreeable to English taste But the endeavour of the present translator has been to give in the following pages as literal a rendering as possible of the great work of Vyasa To the purely English reader there is much in the following pages that will strike as ridiculous Those unacquainted with any language but their own are generally very exclusive in matters of taste Having no knowledge of models other than what they meet with in their own tongue the standard they have formed of purity and taste in composition must necessarily be a narrow one The translator however would ill discharge his duty if for the sake of avoiding ridicule he sacrificed fidelity to the original He must represent his author as he is not as he should be to please the narrow taste of those entirely unacquainted with him Mr Pickford in the preface to his English translation of the Mahavira Charita ably defends a close adherence to the original even at the sacrifice of idiom and taste against the claims of what has been called Free Translation which means dressing the author in an outlandish garb to please those to whom he is introduced In the preface to his classical translation of Bhartrihari s Niti Satakam and Vairagya Satakam Mr C H Tawney says I am sensible that in the present attempt I have retained much local colouring *Rediscovering French Science-Fiction in Literature, Film and Comics* Philippe Mather,Sylvain Rheault,2016-02-29 French science fiction SF is as old as the French language Cyrano de Bergerac wrote about a trip to the moon that was published back in 1657 as did Jules Verne in 1865 this time using hard scientific facts The first movie showing a trip to the moon was made by Georges M li s in 1902 In the comics format Herg had Tintin walk on the moon in 1954 15 years before Neil Armstrong These are just a few of the many unique French contributions to SF that rightly deserve to be better known One of the purposes of this collection is to introduce French SF to an English speaking audience Rediscovering French Science Fiction first revisits proto science fiction from authors like Cyrano de Bergerac and Jules Verne before delving into contemporary science fiction works from authors such as Ren Barjavel and Jacques Spitz A contribution from preeminent SF author Elisabeth Vonarburg from Quebec helps to understand the constraints and advantages of writing SF in French A third section is devoted to French SF in movies and graphic novels media where French creators have been recognized worldwide This collection explores many aspects of
