internal or external to the immigrant community and opportunities emanating from the diasporic relationships that these immigrants create are accentuated within the nexus of African global migrations We view the African diaspora in terms of spatial and geographic constructions and propagations of African cultural identities and institutional forms in global domains whose boundaries are not static but rather dynamic complex and multidimensional Simply stated we approach the African diaspora from a perspective that incorporates the historical as well as contemporary postmodern constructions of the Africa s dispersed communities and their associated transnational identity forms
