Gino Patrick Johnston, Peter Leech, 2025-10-07 From veteran hockey reporter Patrick Johnston and Gino's longtime friend Peter Leech comes the authorized biography of Gino Odjick In the 1980s and 90s National Hockey League games were very different from the nimble skill focused displays we see today One of the greatest differences and one of the sport's more popular facets at the time was the widespread presence of enforcers hulking battle scarred players whose main task was to police the sport by chasing down and brawling with opponents who had broken unwritten codes determining which aspects of violence counted as dishonorable or unjustified When hard hitting Vancouver Canucks player Gino Odjick emerged in the early 1990s he quickly became one of the game's most feared enforcers and revered teammates a sign of a new era for the team racking up 296 penalty minutes in the 45 games he played in his rookie season Hailing from Kitigan Zibi an Algonquin community near Maniwaki Quebec Gino was one of the few Indigenous players in the NHL at the time But it was Gino's ferocious play contrasted by his genuinely affable and openhearted personality off the ice that won him a special place in the hearts of Canucks supporters Yet legends often obscure the human stories behind them Patrick Johnston and Peter Leech look beyond Gino's legendary persona drawing on insights from family members friends and teammates to recount Gino's early years in a loving household that was always ready to welcome foster children Gino's father Joe had suffered the lonely traumas of the residential school system and the experience had instilled a commitment in the family to those who were less fortunate The book also details Gino's eventual struggles with alcohol abuse and how he responded by taking on the role of empathetic mentor to young Indigenous people travelling from community to community to hear their stories and offer hope He never wavered in this role even as he confronted serious illnesses including chronic traumatic encephalopathy CTE and the rare blood disorder that he survived for years longer than expected but that eventually led to his death at age fifty two Gino is a moving tribute to a beloved hockey legend

The 1993 Canadiens K.P. Wee, 2020-01-26 Never to be confused with any previous Montreal Canadiens Flying Frenchmen juggernauts who dominated the NHL between the 1950s and 1970s, the 1992-93 Canadiens, whose lone superstar was future Hall of Fame goaltender Patrick Roy, were essentially a nondescript team coming off an embarrassing second-round playoff series sweep against the Boston Bruins the previous spring. Yet these Habs, led by the goaltending of Roy and with timely goals from various unlikely heroes, stunned the hockey world by winning a record 10 consecutive playoff overtime games over a magical seven-week run during the spring of 1993. Montreal ultimately captured hockey's ultimate prize that June, the 24th championship in franchise history, in the last Stanley Cup Finals series ever played at the venerable Montreal Forum. While the Canadiens had veteran presence in Kirk Muller, Vincent Damphousse, Brian Bellows, Denis Savard, and Guy Carbonneau, Montreal might not have won the Cup without unlikely heroes like Gilbert Dionne, Stephan Lebeau, and Paul DiPietro, scoring goals in the clutch. Others such as Gary Leeman and Mario Roberge, despite not always being in the lineup, contributed in ways that didn't necessarily show up on the scoresheet. And behind the bench, while Jacques Demers made all the right moves that spring, he isn't even considered today among the top 50 coaches of all time.
