Real People and the Rise of Reality Television Michael McKenna,2015 The origins of and in many ways the prototype for modern reality programming can be traced to Real People a show that premiered on the NBC network in April of 1979 An instant ratings success Real People appealed to an audience that clamored for stories about everyday men and women However many of the vignettes focused on individuals who were far from average eccentric collectors allegedly talented performers and inspirational overachievers many of whom could be
