Valente, Stefanie Lemke, María Daniela Núñez Burbano de Lara, 2015-12-07 This book introduces the human right to adequate food and nutrition as evolving concept and identifies two structural disconnects fueling food insecurity for a billion people and disproportionately affecting women children and rural food producers the separation of women s rights from their right to adequate food and nutrition and the fragmented attention to food as commodity and the medicalization of nutritional health Three conditions arising from these disconnects are discussed structural violence and discrimination frustrating the realization of women s human rights as well as their private and public contributions to food and nutrition security for all many women s experience of their and their children s simultaneously independent and intertwined subjectivities during pregnancy and breastfeeding being poorly understood in human rights law and abused by poorly regulated food and nutrition industry marketing practices and the neoliberal economic system s interference both with the autonomy and self determination of women and their communities and with the strengthening of sustainable diets based on democratically governed local food systems The book calls for a social movement led reconceptualization of the right to adequate food toward incorporating gender women s rights and nutrition based on the food sovereignty framework

rights in general and the right to adequate food in particular UN agencies scholars interested governments and civil society have joined forces in attempting to provide a foundation for national and international follow up of the recommendations of the World Food Summit reinforced by the Millennium Development Goals This first of two volumes provides evidence of some of this work and gives direction for future activities to promote and protect the right to adequate food for all It has contributions from some 15 authors who have all been directly involved from different angles in the advancement of the right to food and related human rights over the past years Besides introducing the concept of the right to food and elaborating on its theoretical basis and meaning in development it provides several recent examples from work both at the national and international level to apply it in practical situations and with a special view to how to go about identifying the corresponding obligations of states and complementary duties and responsibilities of non state actors and international organisations Finally several chapters address the right to food under special circumstances and for special groups needing particular attention The book is the first of its kind on the right to food as a human right It is not a textbook but is intended to inform and stimulate further debate among scholars policy makers and practitioners and activists alike on some of the major issues of concern in applying a right based approach to alleviating food insecurity hunger and malnutrition and in promoting access to and consumption of nutritionally adequate safe and culturally acceptable food on a sustainable basis for all It is now evident that with the current pace of events the goal set by the WFS and the MDG of halving poverty and hunger by 2015 will not be achieved There is a growing need to watch some of the possible effects of rapid economic globalisation and market liberalisation on food and nutrition security conditions and to promote countervailing measures to offset their most negative consequences particularly for vulnerable groups The right to food is a first test case of the extent to which the application of economic social and cultural rights can effectively exert such counterforce in an increasingly economics and market driven international climate and enhance progress towards established goals

The State of Food Security and Nutrition in the World 2019 Food and Agriculture Organization of the United Nations, International Fund for Agricultural Development , World Food Programme, World Health Organization, United Nations Children's Fund, 2019-07-15 This year s report presents evidence that the absolute number of people who suffer from hunger continues to slowly increase The report also highlights that food insecurity is more than just hunger For the first time the report provides evidence that many people in the world even if not hungry experience moderate food insecurity as they face uncertainties about their ability to obtain food and are forced to compromise on the quality and or quantity of the food they consume This phenomenon is observed globally not only in low and middle income countries but also in high income countries The report also shows that the world is not on track to meet global nutrition targets including those on low birthweight and on reducing stunting among children under five years Moreover overweight and obesity continue to increase in all regions particularly among school age children and adults The report stresses that no region is exempt from the epidemic of overweight and obesity underscoring the necessity of multifaceted multisectoral approaches to halt and reverse these worrying trends In light of the fragile state of the world economy the report presents new evidence confirming that hunger has been on the rise for many countries where the economy has slowed down or contracted
