

CARDIAC STATUS AND MONITOR

- Cardiovascular Monitoring**
- Monitor vital signs (heart rate, blood pressure, oxygen saturation, respiratory rate, temperature)
 - Monitor ECG (heart rate, rhythm, ST segment, T wave)
 - Monitor central venous pressure (CVP)
 - Monitor pulmonary artery pressure (PAP)
 - Monitor urine output
 - Monitor fluid balance
 - Monitor electrolyte levels (sodium, potassium, calcium, magnesium)
 - Monitor acid-base balance (pH, bicarbonate, base deficit)
 - Monitor coagulation status (PT, aPTT, INR, fibrinogen)
 - Monitor renal function (creatinine, urea, electrolytes)
 - Monitor liver function (ALT, AST, ALP, GGT, bilirubin)
 - Monitor neurological status (consciousness, orientation, motor function, sensory function)
 - Monitor skin integrity (color, temperature, moisture, sensation)
 - Monitor patient comfort (pain, anxiety, nausea, vomiting, constipation, diarrhea)
 - Monitor patient safety (falls, pressure ulcers, infection, bleeding)

- ECG Monitoring**
- Monitor heart rate (normal range: 60-100 bpm)
 - Monitor rhythm (normal sinus rhythm, atrial fibrillation, ventricular tachycardia, etc.)
 - Monitor ST segment (ST depression, ST elevation, etc.)
 - Monitor T wave (T wave inversion, T wave elevation, etc.)
 - Monitor QT interval (normal range: 0.35-0.45 sec)
 - Monitor QTc interval (normal range: 0.35-0.45 sec)
 - Monitor PR interval (normal range: 0.12-0.20 sec)
 - Monitor QRS complex (normal QRS complex, bundle branch block, etc.)

- Endotracheal Tube Monitoring**
- Monitor vital signs (heart rate, blood pressure, oxygen saturation, respiratory rate, temperature)
 - Monitor ECG (heart rate, rhythm, ST segment, T wave)

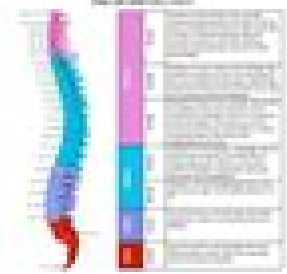
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Neurological Monitoring

Parameter	Normal Range	Abnormal Range	Interpretation
Heart Rate	60-100 bpm	<60 bpm (bradycardia), >100 bpm (tachycardia)	May indicate autonomic dysfunction or pain.
Blood Pressure	90/60-120/80 mmHg	<90/60 mmHg (hypotension), >120/80 mmHg (hypertension)	May indicate autonomic dysfunction or pain.
Oxygen Saturation	95-100%	<95% (hypoxemia)	May indicate respiratory compromise.
Respiratory Rate	12-20 breaths/min	<12 breaths/min (bradypnea), >20 breaths/min (tachypnea)	May indicate respiratory compromise.
Temperature	36.1-37.8°C (96.8-100.0°F)	<36.1°C (hypothermia), >37.8°C (hyperthermia)	May indicate infection or autonomic dysfunction.
ECG	Normal sinus rhythm	Atrial fibrillation, ventricular tachycardia, etc.	May indicate autonomic dysfunction or pain.
CVP	8-12 mmHg	<8 mmHg (hypovolemia), >12 mmHg (hypervolemia)	May indicate fluid balance issues.
PAP	18-25 mmHg	<18 mmHg (hypotension), >25 mmHg (hypertension)	May indicate pulmonary hypertension or other lung issues.
Urine Output	>0.5 mL/kg/hr	<0.5 mL/kg/hr (oliguria)	May indicate renal dysfunction.
Fluid Balance	Intake = Output	Intake > Output (fluid overload), Intake < Output (fluid deficit)	May indicate fluid balance issues.
Electrolytes	Normal levels	Abnormal levels (e.g., hyponatremia, hypokalemia)	May indicate electrolyte imbalances.
Acid-Base Balance	pH 7.35-7.45, HCO3- 22-28 mEq/L, Base Deficit 0-2 mEq/L	Abnormal values (e.g., acidosis, alkalosis)	May indicate metabolic or respiratory issues.
Coagulation Status	Normal PT, aPTT, INR, fibrinogen	Abnormal values (e.g., prolonged PT, aPTT, INR)	May indicate coagulation dysfunction.
Renal Function	Normal creatinine, urea, electrolytes	Abnormal values (e.g., elevated creatinine, urea)	May indicate renal dysfunction.
Liver Function	Normal ALT, AST, ALP, GGT, bilirubin	Abnormal values (e.g., elevated ALT, AST)	May indicate liver dysfunction.
Neurological Status	Normal consciousness, orientation, motor function, sensory function	Abnormal values (e.g., decreased consciousness, motor deficits)	May indicate neurological dysfunction.
Skin Integrity	Normal color, temperature, moisture, sensation	Abnormal values (e.g., discoloration, temperature changes)	May indicate skin issues or circulation problems.
Patient Comfort	Normal pain, anxiety, nausea, vomiting, constipation, diarrhea	Abnormal values (e.g., increased pain, anxiety)	May indicate patient discomfort.
Patient Safety	Normal falls, pressure ulcers, infection, bleeding	Abnormal values (e.g., falls, pressure ulcers)	May indicate patient safety issues.
