Kelly, 2018-10-29 Plea negotiation is rife with due process concerns including a heightened risk of coerced pleas ignoring mens rea serious questions about assistance of counsel limited discovery and little litigation of the evidence the conviction of innocent defendants and significant questions about fairness and equity Plea negotiation is also the fast track to criminal conviction tough punishment and mass incarceration From the perspective of public policy plea negotiation perpetuates a harm based retribution focused system of crime and punishment Because of the failures of public health the justice system has become a dumping ground for hundreds of thousands of mentally ill substance addicted and abusing and neurocognitively impaired offenders And because of a tough on crime mentality and lack of information and options the justice system routinely prosecutes and punishes these offenders The evidence is quite clear that punishment does nothing to improve these circumstances and often exacerbates them The result as one would predict is extraordinarily high rates of reoffending propelling the revolving door of the justice system Confronting Underground Justice takes a close look at plea negotiation criminal prosecution public defense and pretrial justice systems and identifies a wide variety of problems and concerns with each William R Kelly and Robert Pitman provide key decision makers with the tools to make better more informed decisions regarding pre trial detention prosecution and plea deals criminal defense and diversion to treatment Critical to this effort is redefining roles responsibilities and the culture of criminal justice by prosecutors judges and defense counsel accepting responsibility for reducing recidivism and embracing problem solving as a primary decision making strategy Kelly and Pitman combine decades of academic research and policy expertise with real world experience in the court system as a judge and prosecutor to develop innovative and comprehensive reform Confronting Underground Justice provides a prescriptive roadmap for how to fundamentally reinvent plea negotiation pre trial decision making criminal prosecution and public defense to effectively reduce recidivism and save money

The Supreme Court's Role in Mass Incarceration William T. Pizzi, 2020-09-17 The Supreme Court s Role in Mass Incarceration illuminates the role of the United States Supreme Court s criminal procedure revolution as a contributing factor to the rise in U S incarceration rates Noting that the increase in mass incarceration began climbing just after the Warren Court years and continued to climb for the next four decades despite the substantial decline in the crime rate the author posits that part of the explanation is the Court s failure to understand that a trial system with robust rights for defendants is not a strong trial system unless it is also reliable and efficient There have been many explanations offered for the sudden and steep escalation in the U S incarceration rate such as it was the war on drugs to it was our harsh sentencing statutes Those explanations have been shown to be

inadequate This book contends that we have overlooked a more powerful force in the rise of our incarceration rate the long line of Supreme Court decisions starting in the Warren Court era that made the criminal justice system so complicated and expensive that it no longer serves to protect defendants For the vast majority of defendants their constitutional rights are irrelevant as they are forced to accept plea bargains or face the prospect of a comparatively harsh sentence if convicted The prospect of a trial once an important restraint on prosecutors in charging has disappeared and plea bargaining rules This book is essential reading for both graduate and undergraduate students in corrections and criminal justice courses as well as judges attorneys and others working in the criminal justice system *Disabling Criminal Justice* Marie Tidball, 2024-02-22

This book considers the governance of autistic defendants and offenders in the UK courts Utilising the social model of disability it considers the dominant strategies of governance including vulnerability which the author argues obscures the rights of disabled people in the criminal justice system In doing so it sheds light on how this group should be governed Drawing on rigorously researched case studies of autistic adult defendants through the court process the book brings together relevant legal and policy literature criminological and criminal justice theory and disability studies to provide insight into the dividing practices that affect the governance of disabled defendants conduct Using interviews with elites and practitioners textual analysis and court observation of eight autistic adult defendants through their court process the book investigates why the status of autistic defendants as disabled under the Equality Act 2010 has been overlooked in criminal justice policy and criminal court decision making It explores the impact of the collateral effects and symbiotic harm of the criminal justice process on family members who support these defendants through the criminal justice process

Reparative Justice in Authoritarian States Brian Wong Yue Shun, 2025-10-30 Wong examines the normative responsibilities of citizens in authoritarian states to address the injustices perpetrated by their governments He challenges prevailing assumptions in political philosophy arguing that certain citizens by virtue of their agency and authorisation of their states bear responsibilities to compensate oppose commemorate or apologise over injustices that take place in such states The book explores the relationship between authoritarian regimes and the citizens who enable or endure them offering a fresh perspective on questions of reparative justice moral agency and accountability in contexts where state actors fail to meet their obligations Drawing upon political philosophy history sociology and international relations it adopts a richly interdisciplinary approach for understanding citizen liability in authoritarian states Case studies encompassing historical examples such as the Soviet Union Indonesia under Suharto South Korea under Park Chung hee through to contemporary cases such as the Iranian Myanmar and Russian states bridge theory and lived experiences illuminating the complex dynamics of justice in non democratic contexts The advancement of a novel General Authorisation View offers original insights that extend beyond authoritarian regimes addressing broader implications of reparative justice for all regime types Posing critical questions about the evolving responsibilities of citizens in shaping just societies this is an indispensable
