

Eduphoria (pdas): Teacher Self Report and Evaluations

Login from school: Click on PISD Apps from your desktop, select Administrative Tools, and then select Eduphoria. If you do not see it there, click on App Depot and install it. It will then show up in PISD Apps.

Login from home: <http://pdas.pisd.edu>

Use your network login and password.

If you are a new teacher and are **not** in the system you will need to choose **My Profile**. Fill it out completely. You will be signing your evaluations and summatives electronically. This will require you to create a secret code while filling out your profile. You will always be able to preview and edit your profile as needed. **Note: If you are an elementary teacher and do not teach a subject, you may choose other for subject.**

You will not be able to login to the system until your principal has assigned an appraiser for you. When that has been done you will then be able to login and see **pdas 2011**. Choose **pdas 2011** and that will allow access to the system.

As a teacher, you can do the following in pdas 2011:

Submit PDAS Sections I, II, & III (Self Report)

View evaluations that your principal has enabled for viewing

Submit your PDAS Sections:

Complete PDAS Self Report Section I by repeating the following for Reading, Writing, Mathematics, Science, Social Studies, Other Objectives and Assessment Processes:

1. Click a category
2. Check the appropriate objectives
3. Click Save on each screen

To submit Section I, click the "Submit Section I" button on the evaluation toolbar. You may update the information in Section I throughout the year.



The process is the same for Sections II & III at the end of the year.
