How to Steal a City Crispian Olver, 2017-10-23 In March 2015 I was tasked by Pravin Gordhan the minister responsible for local government to root out corruption in the Nelson Mandela Bay municipality in the Eastern Cape Over the following eighteen months I led the investigations and orchestrated the crackdown as the hatchet man for the metro's new Mayor Danny Jordaan This is my account of kickbacks rigged contracts and a political party at war with itself *How to Steal a City* is the gripping insider account of this intervention which lays bare how Nelson Mandela Bay metro was bled dry by criminal syndicates and how factional politics within the ruling party abetted that corruption As a former senior state official

and local government fixer Crispian Olver was no stranger to dodgy politicians and broken organisations Yet what he found in Nelson Mandela Bay went far beyond rigged contracts blatant conflicts of interest and garden variety kickbacks The city's administration had evolved into a sophisticated web of front companies criminal syndicates and compromised local politicians and officials The metro was effectively controlled by a criminal network closely allied to a dominant local ANC faction What Olver found was complete state capture a microcosm of what has taken place in national government Olver and his team initiated a clean up of the administration clearing out corrupt officials and rebuilding public trust Then came the ANC's doomed campaign for the August 2016 local government elections Having lost its way in factional battles and corruption the divided party went down to a humiliating defeat in its traditional heartland Olver paid a high price for his work in Nelson Mandela Bay Intense political pressure and even threats to his personal safety took a toll on his mental and physical health When his political support was withdrawn he had to flee the city as the forces stacked against him took their revenge This is his story

The Urban Refugee Bülent Batuman, Kivanç Kılınç, 2023-11-24 The presence of the refugee in the contemporary metropolis is marked by precarity a quality that has become a characteristic feature of the neoliberal urban milieu Bringing together essays from diverse disciplines from architectural history to cultural anthropology and urban planning this collection sheds light on both the specificities of the contemporary urban condition that affects the refugees and the multi dimensional impact that the refugees have on the city The authors propose investigating this connection through three interlinked themes identity informality imagination and belonging place transnational homemaking practices and site the navigation of urban space In recent years there has been a significant growth in scholarship on forced migration particularly on the relationship between displacement and the built environment Scholars have focused on spatial practices and forms that arise under conditions of displacement with much attention given to refugee camps and the social and political aspects of temporariness While these issues are important the essays in this volume aim to contribute to a less explored aspect of displacement namely the interaction between refugees and the cities they inhabit In this respect the volume underlines the specificity of the urban refugee as well as their spatial agency and investigates the irreversible effect they have on the contemporary urban condition The authors argue that viewing urban refugees solely as dislocated individuals outside the camp like spaces of containment fails to understand the agency of the urban refugee and the blurred boundaries of identity that result The term refugee crisis objectifies and denies active agency to refugees homogenizing dislocated individuals and groups The neoliberalization of the past four decades has led to the precarization of labour and the displacement of refugees who frequently blend into the urban environment as hidden populations Refugees are subjected to constant surveillance and the state's attempts to control them However these attempts are not uncontested and the involvement of activist interventions further politicizes the urban refugee

Experiments with Truth Hedley Twidle, 2019 Unusable pasts scandalous lives political betrayal confession and collaboration reading narrative non fiction across South Africa's unfinished transition Over the last decades South Africa has seen an outpouring of life writing and narrative non fiction Authors like Panashe Chigumadzi Jacob Dlamini Mark Gevisser Pumla Gobodo Madikizela Antjie Krog Sisonke Msimang Njabulo Ndebele Jonny Steinberg and Ivan Vladislavic have produced a compelling and often controversial body of work exploring the country's ongoing political and social transition with great ambition texture and risk *Experiments with Truth* is the first book length account of non fiction in South African literature It reads the country's transition as refracted through an array of documentary modes that are simultaneously refashioned and blurred into each other long form analytic journalism and reportage experiments in oral history microhistory and archival reconstruction life writing memoir and the essay It traces the strange and ethically complex process by which real people places and events are shuffled patterned and plotted in long form prose narrative While holding in mind the
