Disasters and the Roman Imagination Virginia M. Closs, Elizabeth Keitel, 2020-09-21 This book affords new perspectives on urban disasters in the ancient Roman context attending not just to the material and historical realities of such events but also to the imaginary and literary possibilities offered by urban disaster as a figure of thought Existential threats to the ancient city took many forms including military invasions natural disasters public health crises and gradual systemic collapses brought on by political or economic factors In Roman cities the memory of such events left lasting imprints on the city in psychological as well as in material terms Individual chapters explore historical disasters and their commemoration

but others also consider of the effect of anticipated and imagined catastrophes They analyze the destruction of cities both as a threat to be forestalled and as a potentially regenerative agent of change and the ways in which destroyed cities are revisited and in a sense rebuilt in literary and social memory The contributors to this volume seek to explore the Roman conception of disaster in terms that are not exclusively literary or historical Instead they explore the connections between and among various elements in the assemblage of experiences texts and traditions touching upon the theme of urban disasters in the Roman world

The Arena of Satire David H. J. Larmour, 2016-01-04 In this first comprehensive reading of Juvenal's satires in more than fifty years David H J Larmour deftly revises and sharpens our understanding of the second century Roman writer who stands as the archetype for all later practitioners of the satirist's art The enduring attraction of Juvenal's satires is twofold they not only introduce the character of the angry satirist but also offer vivid descriptions of everyday life in Rome at the height of the Empire In Larmour's interpretation these two elements are inextricably linked The Arena of Satire presents the satirist as flaneur traversing the streets of Rome in search of its authentic core those distinctly Roman virtues that have disappeared amid the corruption of the age What the vengeful punishing satirist does to his victims as Larmour shows echoes what the Roman state did to outcasts and criminals in the arena of the Colosseum The fact that the arena was the most prominent building in the city and is mentioned frequently by Juvenal makes it an ideal lens through which to examine the spectacular and punishing characteristics of Roman satire And the fact that Juvenal undertakes his search for the uncorrupted authentic Rome within the very buildings and landmarks that make up the actual corrupt Rome of his day gives his sixteen satires their uniquely paradoxical and contradictory nature Larmour's exploration of the arena of satire guides us through Juvenal's search for the true Rome winding from one poem to the next He combines close readings of passages from individual satires with discussions of Juvenal's representation of Roman space and topography the nature of the arena experience and the network of connections among the satirist the gladiator and the editor or producer of Colosseum entertainments The Arena of Satire also offers a new definition of Juvenalian satire as a particular form arising from the intersection of the body and the urban landscape a form whose defining features survive in the works of several later satirists from Jonathan Swift and Evelyn Waugh to contemporary writers such as Russian novelist Victor Pelevin and Irish dramatist Martin McDonagh

Horace Paul Allen Miller, 2018-12-18 Perhaps no classical writer has been so consistently in vogue as Horace Famous in his own lifetime as a close associate of the Emperor Octavian

to whom he dedicated several odes Quintus Horatius Flaccus 65 8 BC has never really been out of fashion Petrarch for example modelled his letters on Horace s innovative Epistles while also borrowing from his Roman forebear in composing his own Italian sonnets The echo of Horace s voice can be found in almost every genre of medieval literature And in later periods this influence and popularity if anything increased Yet as Paul Allen Miller shows while Horace may justifiably be called the poet for all seasons he is also in the end an enigma His elusive ironic contrariness is perhaps the true secret of his success A cultured man of letters he fought on the losing side of the Battle of Philippi 42 BC A staunch Republican he ended up eagerly some said too eagerly promoting the cause of Julio Claudian imperialism Viewed as the acme of Roman literary civilization he was shaped by his Athens education at Plato s famous Academy This new introduction reveals Horace in all his paradoxical genius and complexity
