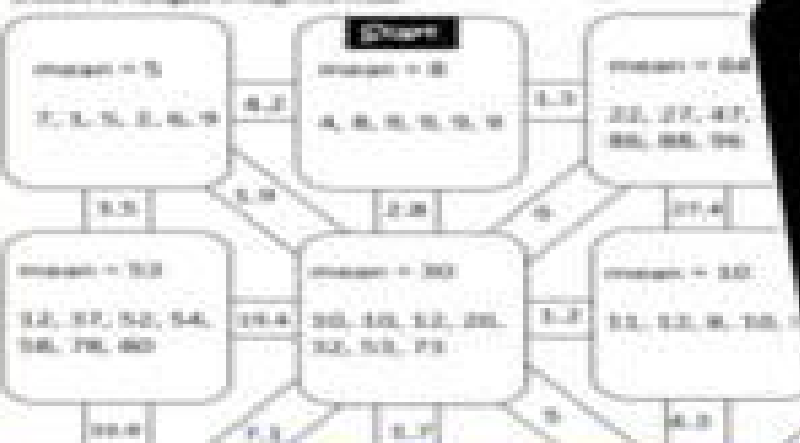

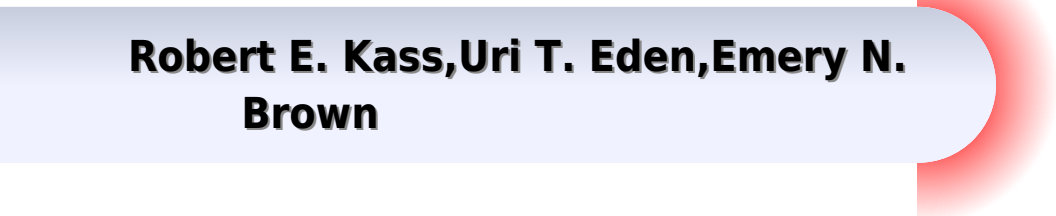

Capital Theory and Political Economy Leteris Tsoulfidis, 2021-05-30 In recent years there have been a number of new developments in what came to be known as the Capital Theory Debates The debates took place mainly during the 1960s as a result of Piero Sraffa's critique of the neoclassical theory according to which the prices of factors of production directly depend on their relative scarcities Sraffa showed that when income distribution changes there are many complexities developed within the economic system impacting on prices in ways which are not possible to predict These debates were revisited in the 1980s and again more recently along with a parallel literature that has developed among neoclassical economists and has also looked at the impact of shocks on an economy This book summarizes the debates and issues around the theory of capital and brings to the fore the more recent developments It also pinpoints the similarities and differences between the various approaches and critically evaluates them in light of available empirical evidence The focus of the book is on the price trajectories induced by changes in income distribution and the resulting shape of the wage rates of profit curves and frontier These issues are central to areas such as microeconomics international trade growth technological change and macro stability analysis Each chapter starts with the theoretical issues involved followed by their formalization and subsequently with their operationalization More specifically the variables of the classical theory of value and distribution are rigorously defined and quantified using actual input output data from a number of major economies but mainly from the USA over long stretches of time The empirical results are not only consistent with the anticipations of the theory but also further inform and therefore strengthen its predictive content raising new significant questions **Topics and Trends in Current**

Advanced Data Assimilation for Geosciences Marc Bocquet, Éric Blayo, Emmanuel Cosme, Leticia F. Cugliandolo, 2014 Data assimilation aims at determining as accurately as possible the state of a dynamical system by combining heterogeneous sources of information in an optimal way. Generally speaking, the mathematical methods of data assimilation describe algorithms for forming optimal combinations of observations of a system, a numerical model that describes its evolution and appropriate prior information. Data assimilation has a long history of application to high dimensional geophysical systems dating back to the 1960s with application to the estimation of initial conditions for weather forecasts. It has become a major component of numerical forecasting systems in geophysics and an intensive field of research with numerous additional applications in oceanography, atmospheric chemistry and extensions to other geophysical sciences. The physical complexity and the high dimensionality of geophysical systems have led the community of geophysics to make significant contributions to the fundamental theory of data assimilation. This book gathers notes from lectures and seminars given by internationally recognized scientists during a three week school held in the Les Houches School of physics in 2012 on theoretical and applied data assimilation. It is composed of i) a series of main lectures presenting the fundamentals of the most commonly used methods and the information theory background required to understand and evaluate the role of observations ii) a series of specialized lectures addressing various aspects of data assimilation in detail from the most recent developments of the theory to the specificities of various thematic applications.

Model-Free Prediction and Regression Dimitris N. Politis, 2015-11-13 The Model Free Prediction Principle expounded upon in this monograph is based on the simple notion of transforming a complex dataset to one that is easier to work with, e.g. iid or Gaussian. As such, it restores the emphasis on observable quantities, i.e. current and future data, as opposed to unobservable model parameters and estimates thereof, and yields optimal predictors in diverse settings such as regression and time series. Furthermore, the Model Free Bootstrap takes us beyond point prediction in order to construct frequentist prediction intervals without resort to unrealistic assumptions such as normality. Prediction has been traditionally approached via a model-based paradigm, i.e. fit a model to the data at hand and then use the fitted model to extrapolate/predict future data. Due to both mathematical and computational constraints, 20th-century statistical practice focused mostly on parametric models. Fortunately, with the advent of widely accessible, powerful computing in the late 1970s, computer-intensive methods such as the bootstrap and cross-validation freed practitioners from the limitations of parametric models and paved the way towards the big data era of the 21st century. Nonetheless, there is a further step one may take, i.e. going beyond even nonparametric models: this is where the Model Free Prediction Principle is useful. Interestingly, being able to predict a response variable Y associated with a regressor variable X taking on any possible value seems to inadvertently also achieve the main goal of modeling, i.e. trying to describe how Y depends on X . Hence, as prediction can be treated as a by-product of model fitting, key estimation problems can be addressed as a by-product of being able to perform prediction. In other words, a practitioner can use Model Free Prediction ideas in order to additionally obtain point estimates and confidence intervals for relevant parameters, leading to an alternative transformation-based approach to statistical inference.
