Meaning and the Moral Sciences Hilary Putnam, 1978 The Vital Science (Routledge Revivals) Peter Morton, 2014-08-01 In this title first published in 1984 Peter Morton argues that in late Victorian Britain a group of novelists and essayists quite consciously sought and found ideas in post Darwinian biology that were susceptible to imaginative transformation The period between 1860 and 1900 was a time of great confusion in biology the natural selection hypothesis was in retreat before its acute critics and no extension of evolutionary theory to human affairs was too bizarre to attract its quota of enthusiasts Writers capitalised on this prevailing uncertainty and used it to their own artistic or polemic ends A fascinating and interdisciplinary title this reissue will interest students of late Victorian literature as well as historians of

biological theory between The Origin of Species and Mendel *Routledge Revivals: The Greatest Happiness Principle* (1986) Lanny Ebenstein, 2018-04-17 First published in 1991 The Greatest Happiness Principle traces the history of the theory of utility starting with the Bible and running through Plato Aristotle and Epicurus It goes on to discuss the utilitarian theories of Jeremy Bentham and John Stuart Mill in detail commenting on the latter's view of the Christianity of his day and his optimal socialist society The book argues that the key theory of utility is fundamentally concerned with happiness stating that happiness has largely been left out of discussions of utility It also goes on to argue that utility can be used as a moral theory ultimately posing the question what is happiness The Fascination of Film Violence Henry Bacon, 2015-04-07 The Fascination of Film Violence is a study of why fictional violence is such an integral part of fiction film How can something dreadful be a source of art and entertainment Explanations are sought from the way social and cultural norms and practices have shaped biologically conditioned violence related traits in human behavior **I. Richards (Routledge Revivals)** John Paul Russo, 2015-06-11 A pioneering critic educator and poet I A Richards 1893 1979 helped the English speaking world decide not only what to read but how to read it Acknowledged father of New Criticism he produced the most systematic body of critical writing in the English language since Coleridge His method of close reading dominated the English speaking classroom for half a century John Paul Russo draws on close personal acquaintance with Richards as well as on unpublished materials correspondence and interviews to write the first biography originally published in 1989 of one of last century's most influential and many sided men of letters **Is Water H₂O?** Hasok Chang, 2012-05-23 This book exhibits deep philosophical quandaries and intricacies of the historical development of science lying behind a simple and fundamental item of common sense in modern science namely the composition of water as H₂O Three main phases of development are critically re examined covering the historical period from the 1760s to the 1860s the Chemical Revolution through which water first became recognized as a compound not an element early electrochemistry by which water's compound nature was confirmed and early atomic chemistry in which water started out as HO and became H₂O In each case the author concludes that the empirical evidence available at the time was not decisive in settling the central debates and therefore the consensus that was reached was unjustified or at least premature This leads to a significant re examination of the realism question in the philosophy of science and a unique new advocacy for pluralism in science Each chapter contains three layers allowing readers to follow various parts of the book at their chosen level of depth and detail The second major study in complementary science this book offers a rare combination of philosophy history and science in a bid to improve scientific knowledge through history and philosophy of science **Art and Moral Change** Ki Joo Choi, 2024-09-02 A first of its kind critical overview of how art leads to moral action in the field of theological ethics One question that remains insufficiently addressed in theological ethics is the question of how art leads to moral action While many modernist theories consider art to be a morally irrelevant activity others think that the arts and the emotions they elicit are integral to moral formation and justice

Darwin and Spencer In the ongoing debate on the political element in political economy he reveals himself to have been as much an eclectic as was Adam Smith and as much a man of commitment as was T H Green
