from this tradition of Shi i Islam discovered in India the Middle East and Central Asia amongst other regions He also played a key role in the establishment of the Ismaili Society the first research institution of its kind with a major collection of Ismaili manuscripts Ivanow made these manuscripts available to other scholars thereby contributing to further progress in the field Ivanow completed his memoirs entitled Fifty Years in the East in 1968 shortly before his death This work originally written in Russian is comprised of an autobiography and vivid accounts from his travels These convey his ethnologist s interest in the archaeology of the way of life and profound curiosity for regional customs and languages The memoirs written in Tehran during Ivanow s final years have now been edited with substantial annotations by Farhad Daftary They reveal for the first time the circumstances under which modern Ismaili studies were initiated and an eyewitness account of several regions during the early decades of the twentieth century before the rapid onset of modernisation
