Entering New Data

1. Click on a cell, or move to it with the arrow keys.
2. Type the data in your active cell and then press **Enter** or the **Return** key to input the data.
3. Press **Enter** or **Ctrl+Enter** in the formula bar. The formula bar is located above your worksheet, and displays the data or formula that is the active cell. It also suggests an entry, such as dates, to insert, or data to remove, or gives it a default value.

Adding from a Drop-Down List

To get a list of values to add to a cell, click on the cell below or above the cell you want to add a list. Then use the arrow keys to select the data you want to add.

Editing the Contents of a Cell

1. Click on the cell to change.
2. Click on the formula bar. Or, double-click in the cell. Double-click the cell to edit the data in the cell.
3. Use arrow keys to move the cursor to the data in the cell. Double-click to edit the data in the cell.
4. When finished, press **Enter** or **Ctrl+Enter** to save the data.
