A European Elizabethan David Scott Gehring, 2024-06-24 Robert Beale 1541-1601 was a diplomat and administrator who worked at the heart of Elizabethan governance and international policymaking In spite or perhaps because of the voluminous record he left behind he has never been the subject of a dedicated biography and his remarkable life and influence have therefore remained hidden By thoroughly investigating Beales personal reference archive which remains largely intact at the British Library and additional material from archives across the UK mainland Europe and the USA this book brings Beales life into sharp focus from his shadowy upbringing in Coventry and London through his first trips to the European mainland in the 1550s and to his prominent roles in Queen Elizabeths government By reconstructing the complex web of transnational connections he forged throughout Europe David Scott Gehring demonstrates for the first time the extent to which these networks and his experiences abroad made him an invaluable agent of the Elizabethan regime In the process Gehring reveals Beales broader significance for our understanding of the workings of Elizabethan government especially the role of second and third level players within it and he recognizes the impossibility of truly understanding Elizabethan England without considering its interactions with and connections to the rest of Europe The book makes a range of novel contributions including to understandings of Elizabethan foreign policy the succession religion political life and intelligence gathering

Shakespeare Before Shakespeare Glyn Parry, Cathryn Enis, 2020-08-07 Before William Shakespeare wrote world famous plays on the themes of power and political turmoil the Shakespeare family of Stratford upon Avon and their neighbors and friends were plagued by false accusations and feuds with the government conflicts that shaped Shakespeares sceptical understanding of the realities of power This ground breaking study of the world of the young William Shakespeare in Stratford and Warwickshire discusses many recent archival discoveries to consider three linked families the Shakespeares the Dudleys and the Ardens and their battles over regional power and government corruption Robert Dudley earl of Leicester and Ambrose Dudley earl of Warwick used politics the law history and lineage to establish their authority in Warwickshire and Stratford challenging political and social structures and collective memory in the region The resistance of Edward Arden

often claimed as kin to Mary Arden Shakespeare's mother and his friends and family culminated in his execution on false treason charges in 1583. By then the Shakespeare family also had direct experience with the London government's power in 1569. Exchequer informers backed by influential politicians at Court accused John Shakespeare, William's father, of illegal wool dealing and usury. Despite previous claims that John had resolved these charges by 1572, the book's new sources show the Exchequer's continuing demands forced his withdrawal from Stratford politics by 1577 and undermined his business career in the early 1580s when young William first gained an understanding of his father's troubles. At the same time, Edward Arden's condemnation by the Elizabethan regime proved problematic for the Shakespeares' friends and neighbours, the Quineys, who were accused of maintaining financial connections to the traitorous Ardens, though Stratford people were convinced of their innocence. This complicated community directly impacted Shakespeare's own perspective on local and national politics and social structures, connecting his early experiences in Stratford and Warwickshire with many of the themes later found in his plays.

Unexpected Heirs in Early Modern Europe Valerie Schutte, 2017-10-24. There were many surprising accessions in the early modern period, including Mary I of England, Henry III of France, Anne Stuart, and others, but this is the first book dedicated solely to evaluating their lives and the repercussions of their reigns. By comparing a variety of such unexpected heirs, this engaging history offers a richer portrait of early modern monarchy. It shows that the need for heirs and the acquisition and preparation of heirs had a critical impact on sixteenth and seventeenth-century culture and politics, from the appropriation of culture to the influence of language to trade and political alliances. It also shows that securing a dynasty relied on more than just political agreements and giving birth to legitimate sons, examining how relationships between women could and did forge alliances and dynastic continuities.

Tudor Networks of Power Ruth Ahnert, Sebastian E. Ahnert, 2024-02-16. *Tudor Networks of Power* is the product of a groundbreaking collaboration between an early modern book historian and a physicist specializing in complex networks. Together, they have reconstructed and computationally analysed the networks of intelligence, diplomacy, and political influence across a century of Tudor history, 1509-1603, based on the British State Papers. The 130,000 letters that survive in the State Papers from the Tudor period provide crucial information about the textual organization of the social network centred on the Tudor government. Whole libraries have been written using this archive, but until now, nobody has had access to the macroscopic tools that allow us to ask questions such as: What are the reasons for the structure of the Tudor government's intelligence network? What was its geographical reach and coverage? Can we use network data to show patterns of surveillance? What role did women play in these government networks? And what biases are there in the data? The authors employ methods from the field of network science, translating key concepts and approaches into a language accessible to literary scholars and historians, and illustrating them with examples drawn from this fantastically rich archive. Each chapter is the product of a set of thematically organized experiments which show how particular methods can help to ask and answer research questions specific to the
