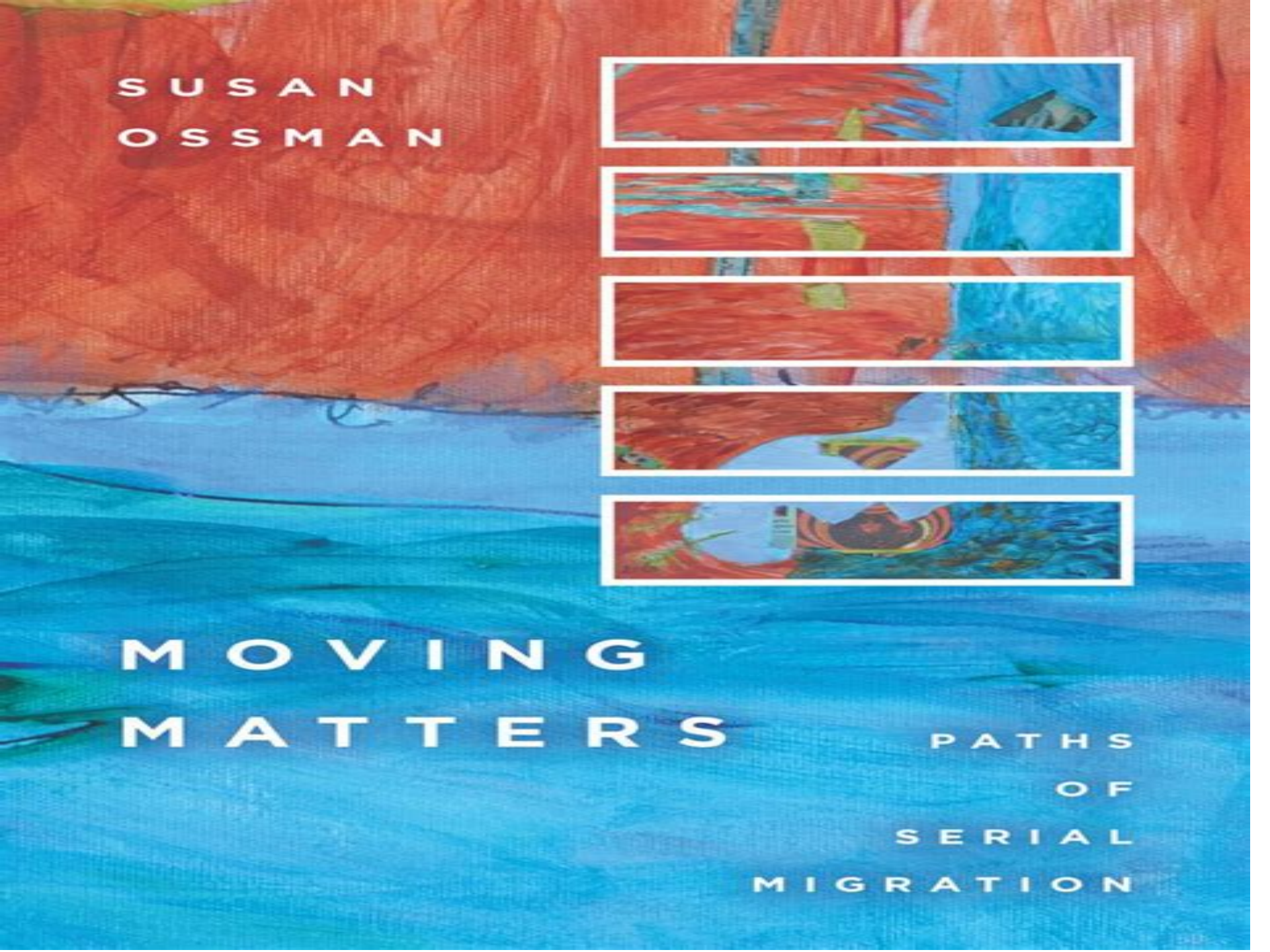

Moving Matters Susan Ossman, 2013-01-09 *Moving Matters* is a richly nuanced portrait of the serial migrant a person who has lived in several countries calling each one at some point home The stories told here are both extraordinary and increasingly common Serial migrants rarely travel freely they must negotiate a world of territorial borders and legal restrictions yet as they move from one country to another they can use border crossings as moments of self clarification They often become masters of settlement as they turn each country into a life chapter Susan Ossman follows this diverse and growing population not only to understand how paths of serial movement produce certain ways of life but also to illuminate an ongoing tension between global fluidity and the power of nation states Ultimately her lyrical reflection on migration and social diversity offers an illustration of how taking mobility as a starting point fundamentally alters our understanding of subjectivity politics and social life
